We are confident that our prices represent true value to families in their time of need. If you plan to make price comparisons with other funeral providers, please be sure to check that you compare like for like and that **all** costs are included in the quoted price.

Also be aware that facilities, vehicles and most importantly, the level of care isn't the same with every funeral director.

When comparing costs, it is important to consider the level of service you will receive and the standards of care and professionalism you and your loved one's deserve. Every Funeral Director in the UK is legally required to provide families with a 'Standardised Price List' however the service you receive and the facilities a Funeral Director provides are not standard, therefore it is difficult to use this measure as a comparison.

We will use our hearse and four bearers for this simple funeral NOT a people carrier or van and WILL NOT make a charge for administering charity donations, unlike some other firms.

These have to be displayed both on websites and in prominent positions within premises. The aim of this is to show a like for like price for funerals.

The CMA standardised pricelist is somewhat different to how we have always shown our prices and whilst we are fully behind the CMA in having a standard price list to make it easier to compare prices, their format can appear more confusing.

Funeral directors are not allowed to change the format or wording of the STANDARDISED PRICELIST and although in the past we have never charged families for coming to the chapel to see their loved one or for collecting Cremated Remains from the crematorium, the CMA have insisted that we now charge, hence why there is a nominal charge of £1.00.

Unfortunately, the 'Standardised Price List' does not include or have provision to include some of the many services Armstrongs offer in our 'Tailored Funeral' which is why we have produced a more detailed price list.

TYPICAL FUNERAL PRICING

Our price for this service is **£2460**

For most families, a funeral would be a bespoke service provided by their funeral director.

Our Tailored Service includes the following:

- Making all necessary arrangements and obtaining all necessary legal documents
- Choice of day and time of funeral (third party dependent)
- The availability of professionally trained staff, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
- Bringing the deceased into our care during normal office hours (within 20 miles)
- Use of the Chapel of Rest by arrangement during office hours
- The provision of a hearse, 4 bearers and the attendance of the Funeral Director at the funeral
- Service at a local crematorium or place of worship including a hearse (Mercedes or Vintage VW)
- Collection of ashes from the crematorium
- Delivery of ashes to home address (within a 10 mile radius)
- Administration of charitable donations
- Memorial webpage / online obituary
- Organising of Orders of Service
- Arranging floral tributes

STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only) £2080

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation

Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements £375

Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care £274

Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at both the funeral director's branch premises and at other non-branch premises £580

Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from wood effect veneer £295

Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer) £1

At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle £470

UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself

Burial (funeral director's charges only) From £1,450

Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee)² £1,450

FEES YOU MUST PAY

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the **burial fee**.¹

In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is: £700-£2,000

For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.

For an Attended cremation funeral, the **cremation fee**.²

In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is: £1065

Please discuss any **specific religious, belief-based and/or cultural requirements** that you have with the funeral director.

ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES

This funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include:

Additional mileage (price per mile) £1.80

Additional transfers of the deceased person's body (e.g. to their home, to a place of worship etc.) (price per transfer) £160 - £250

Collection and delivery of ashes From £1

Embalming £120

Funeral officiant (e.g. celebrant, minister of religion etc.) Prices on request

Services supplied outside of normal office hours Prices on request

The funeral director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier.

¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
